The U.S. International Development Finance Corporation has announced a \$3.1 million technical assistance grant to support Weza Power to accelerate its work expanding grid access across Burundi.

In April 2024, a major step toward improving electricity access in Burundi was achieved through a partnership between the International Finance Corporation (IFC), Virunga Power and the government of Burundi.

Weza Power, the new entity, is expected to bring grid power to connect nearly 9mn people and around 70% of Burundi's population. It is the result of a multi-year development partnership between Virunga ...
