The Facilities Management team will utilize various techniques to measure building performance, investigate anomalies, and develop energy priorities, suggestions, and management techniques.

This policy applies to all St. Johns County owned and operated buildings, grounds, and facilities, and to all staff, contractors, and visitors who utilize these facilities.

To serve the needs of our community and the City of Saint John, Saint John Energy has constituted a governance body consisting of a Board of Commissioners appointed by the Saint John Common Council.
